

Justification – Part One

“Justification in the Old Testament”

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“Tsadaq”, “Tsedeq”, & “Tsaddiyq” family

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Deut. 32:4 – It describes an attribute of God

II Sam. 23:3 – It’s the foundation of God’s rule

Jer. 23:5-6 – It describes Messiah’s character

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Vs. 20, 24, 28: “*Justify*” = “*dikaioo*”

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See Rom. 3:19-31:

Vs. 20, 24, 28: *“Justify”* = *“dikaioo”*

Vs. 21-22, 25-26: *“righteous”* = *“dikaiosune”*

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In LXX: *“Dika”* family of Greek words is used to translate *“Tsadaq”* family of Hebrew words

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“The Heart of the Gospel”

Note Job’s Question in *Job 9:2*

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Now see *Rom. 1:16-18*

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The ‘Gospel’ is all about the answer to Job’s question!

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See *Rom. 3:23-25* – Work backwards!

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Thru the cross, God can justify the *“un-godly”* (i.e. *unjust*), yet be just in doing so.

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See *Rom. 3:26 & 4:5*

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Grace is the **MECHANISM of conveying it!**

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Faith is the **MEANS whereby we obtain it!**
